- 5 Q. Let me direct your attention to a road
- 6 that's marked on Exhibit 10 as Manganese Road/0063,
- 7 and you've mentioned that early in your testimony.
- 8 Are you familiar with that road?
- 9 A. Yes, I am.
- 10 Q. When did you first become aware of that
- 11 road?
- 12 A. That would have probably been in the
- 13 '50s. Yes, it would have been in the '50s because
- 14 that road has been there for a long time.
- Q. Why were you first on that road? Do you
- 16 recall?
- 17 A. We hunted in there off of that road in
- 18 the '50s and '60s.
- 19 Q. Do you know whether that is maintained
- 20 road? Is it bladed?
- 21 A. It is now. I don't know whether it was
- 22 then or not.
- Q. And do you know when it was first bladed?
- 24 A. No, I don't.
- Q. There is a complex of roads that sits to

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1 the northeast of Manganese Road and the west of Tobin

- 2 Wash Road. Do you see the roads I'm talking about?
- 3 A. Yes.
- 4 Q. Now, are you generally familiar with
- 5 those roads?
- 6 A. Yes.
- 7 Q. Are those roads that you've used for
- 8 hunting?
- 9 A. Yes.
- 10 Q. And when did you start hunting that area
- 11 generally?
- 12 A. This road here, Tony, was put in -- this
- 13 is the old Powerline Road. It comes down in and
- 14 crosses the Manganese Wash. Now, when that power
- 15 line was put in there, I can't tell you. But that is
- 16 the road that comes off of the Tobin Wash Road and
- 17 comes down through here and crosses the Manganese
- 18 Wash.
- 19 Q. All right. You're referring to a road
- 20 that's marked on Exhibit 10 as 0127 and becomes 0129
- 21 on its -- on the southern end as it joins Manganese
- 22 Road.
- A. Mm-hmm.
- Q. Is that all one road?
- 25 A. Yes.

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1 Q. Do you know whether that was put in at

- 2 the same time they put the power line in?
- 3 A. I'm sure that's why it was put in there.
- 4 Well, I would say that's why it was put in there.
- 5 I'm not sure. But that -- that's the one -- we
- 6 travel it all the time now on our four-wheelers, and
- 7 that's what it -- that's what it does. There's
- 8 little side roads that goes off to the power line,
- 9 power poles. But that road is there, yes.
- 10 Q. When do you believe you were first on
- 11 that road?
- 12 MS. STIMMEL: And for the record, I think
- 13 we should make clear whether or not you're also
- 14 talking about the portion of the road marked 0127 that
- 15 turns to the southeast when it meets up with --
- MR. RAMPTON: I see.
- 17 MS. STIMMEL: -- 0129.
- 18 Q. (BY MR. RAMPTON) All right. 0127 wraps
- 19 around and actually ties back into Manganese Road
- 20 further to the southeast. Do you see that stretch?
- 21 A. Yes.
- Q. All right. Let's talk about the loop --
- 23 the entire loop that is 0127.
- 24 A. Okay. I know that we hunted on this road
- 25 here from this point up into here. But as far as

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1 that road up in there, I'm not sure when that -- when

- 2 that went through. Whether it was there or not, this
- 3 was as far as we would go in.
- 4 Q. All right. So you've pointed to a
- 5 section of 0127 that runs from Manganese Road
- 6 northwest until it adjoins 0129. Is that the road
- 7 you're talking about?
- 8 A. Yes.
- 9 Q. And when did you start hunting that road?
- 10 A. We hunted that -- we started hunting it
- 11 back in the '50s, in that area.
- 12 Q. The section of road that is 0129, are you
- 13 familiar with that stretch of the road?
- 14 A. I am, yes, because we run it on the
- 15 four-wheelers, yes. But like I say, that whole thing
- 16 comes clear through here into the Manganese Road.
- 17 When that was put in, I'm not sure.
- 18 Q. Okay.
- 19 Directing your attention to a road that's
- 20 marked on Exhibit 10 as 0128, do you see that stretch
- 21 of road?
- A. Mm-hmm.
- Q. Are you familiar with that road?
- 24 A. It comes out of Gunlock. No, I'm not. I
- 25 wasn't aware there was a road that was there.
