

Dominguez-Escalante National Conservation Area

Dominguez-Escalante National Conservation Area was designated by the Omnibus Public Land Management Act of 2009. The newest NCA in Colorado, its designation was supported by local, regional and national interests in recognition of the outstanding resources in the area.

Facts

- 210,172 acres
- 1 wilderness area (66,280 acres in the Dominguez Canyon Wilderness Area)
- 7 Recreation Management Areas (128,104 acres): Cactus Park, Gunnison River, Escalante Canyon, Sawmill Mesa, Hunting Grounds, Ninemile Hill, East Creek
- 9 recreation sites (2 primitive campgrounds, 1 day-use/picnic area, 5 trail heads, and 2 primitive boat launches)
- 17 grazing allotments
