*The total number of animals removed during gather events in FY2014 is 1,773. In addition, the BLM often removes small numbers of animals that are found outside designated herd management areas and which pose a public safety risk as well as animals that are found on private land and are requested to be removed by private landowners. In FY2014, those removals totaled an additional 85 animals (70 horses and 15 burros).

**The BLM also treated in additional 25 mares that were removed from the range in FY2013. In addition to animals that are treated with fertility control as part of a gather event, the BLM manages fertility control darting programs to control wild horse population growth on the range in herd management areas where the horses are easily identifiable and approachable. In FY2014, the BLM treated an additional 319 mares through its fertility control darting programs, making the total number of mares treated with a fertility control vaccine in FY2014 to be 384.
