## Improve a Habitat!

All living things need food, water, and shelter to survive. Help wildlife fulfill one or more of these basic needs right in your own neighborhood.

#### **Directions**

- 1. Take a walk outside around the place you live. Look for ways animals might find the food, water, and shelter they need.
- 2. Use natural materials you find outside or recycled materials from your home to make habitat improvements that provide additional food, water, or shelter.
- 3. Watch to see what animals take advantage of the improvements you make!

#### **Habitat Helper Tips**

- Be Bear Aware! Avoid putting food-related items outside between mid-April and mid-November.
- Keep yourself and animals safe: Do not touch or get close to wildlife.
- Use materials that are safe for animals.
- Keep feeders and water dishes clean and well stocked.
