

The Copper Rays Solar Project is proposed on approximately 5,130 acres of BLM-managed public land located in the Pahrump Valley in Nye County, southeast of the Town of Pahrump and approximately 40 miles west of Las Vegas.</p> <p>BLM is hosting virtual public information forums as part of the application process. Information gathered during the public input period will inform BLM's determination on whether to continue to process or to deny the application.
