

ADDENDUM

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE
BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT
AND THE
U.S. FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE
TO PROMOTE THE CONSERVATION OF MIGRATORY BIRDS**

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) and the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) (hereinafter referred to as “the Parties”) to Promote the Conservation of Migratory Birds was signed on April 12, 2010, extended on May 15, 2015, and expired on April 12, 2017. Both Parties have agreed to extend the above referenced MOU as currently written while the Parties work together to evaluate the MOU to ensure that it still meets the stated purposes, scope, and responsibilities identified in Executive Order 13186, *Responsibilities of Federal Agencies To Protect Migratory Birds*, 66 Fed. Reg. 3853 (January 17, 2001).

This extension is executed as of the last date signed below and will remain effective until five years after the last signature date, or until a revised MOU is signed by the Parties, whichever comes first. During the MOU evaluation both Parties will identify outdated and unnecessary information. The Parties will exchange recommended changes and work cooperatively to revise the MOU, so that a new MOU between the Parties can be signed that replaces the current Agreement.
