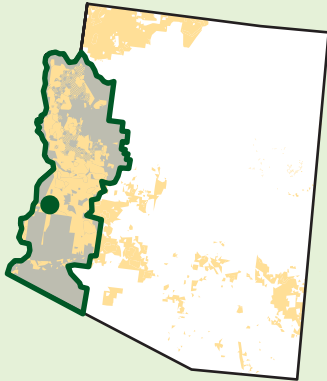

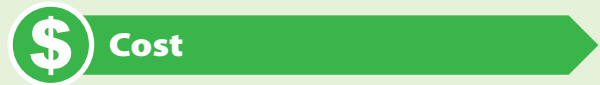

Description: The project will repair the three La Posa Long-Term Visitor Areas (North, South, and West), which were established in 1983, to address the ever-increasing demand for wintertime RV camping opportunities in the Southwest. The project will replace an aging and undersized septic leach field with a wastewater lagoon to prevent groundwater pollution and provide a sustainable solution for handling increasing visitor waste into the future. Additional work includes repaving 6 miles of asphalt-surfaced roads and reconditioning 6.5 miles of natural surface roads to provide the visiting public safe access to nearby recreational activities.

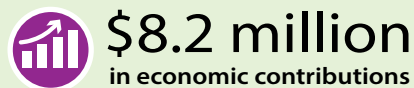
Estimated Deferred Maintenance Reduction:
