

## Ireteba Peaks Wilderness

Bureau of Land Management  
Legal Boundary Description

The Bureau of Land Management Ireteba Peaks Wilderness established in the "Clark County Conservation of Public Land and Natural Resources Act of 2002", Public Law No. 107-282, Bureau of Land Management serial No. N76658, dated November 6, 2002, and is located in Townships 26 and 27 South, Range 64 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Clark County, in the state of Nevada, and is more particularly described as follows:

1. Beginning at the corner of Tps. 26 and 27 S., Rs. 64 and 65 E., thence southerly, a distance of approximately 3.7 miles, on the line between Tps. 27 S., Rs. 64 and 65 E., identical with the western boundary of the National Park Service Ireteba Peaks Wilderness, also identical with the western boundary of the Lake Mead National Recreation Area, to the base of left bank of wash, course southeasterly, identical with the southwest corner of the National Park Service Ireteba Peaks Wilderness, at approximate latitude 35°34'48" North, longitude 114°46'37" West;
2. thence northwesterly, a distance of approximately 0.35 miles, to a knoll, at approximate latitude 35°34'59" North., longitude 114°46'55" West;
3. thence southwesterly, a distance of approximately 0.5 miles, to a spur, slopes southeasterly, at approximate latitude 35°34'49" North, longitude 114°47'25" West;
4. thence southerly, a distance of approximately 0.6 miles, to a spur, slopes southeasterly, at approximate latitude 35°34'17" North, longitude 114°47'25" West;
5. thence southwesterly, a distance of approximately 0.5 miles, to a point, at approximate latitude 35°33'59" North, longitude 114°47'45" West;
6. thence northwesterly, a distance of approximately 0.2 miles, to a knoll, at approximate latitude 35°34'07" North, longitude 114°47'57" West;
7. thence northwesterly, a distance of approximately 0.65 miles, to a spur, slopes easterly, at approximate latitude 35°34'37" North, longitude 114°48'16" West;
8. thence northwesterly, a distance of approximately 0.8 miles, to a saddle of a ridge, bears northeasterly and southwesterly, at approximate latitude 35°35'01" North, longitude 114°48'58" West;
9. thence northwesterly, a distance of approximately 0.4 miles, to a spur, slopes northeasterly, at approximate latitude 35°35'19" North, longitude 114°49'11" West;
10. thence northwesterly, a distance of approximately 0.4 miles, to a spur, slopes easterly, at approximate latitude 35°35'30" North, longitude 114°49'32" West;

11. thence northwesterly, a distance of approximately 0.5 miles, to a spur, slopes northeasterly, at approximate latitude 35°35'53" North, longitude 114°49'47" W.;
12. thence northerly, a distance of approximately 1.6 miles, to a spur, slopes northeasterly, at approximate latitude 35°37'15" North, longitude 114°49'55" West;
13. thence northerly, a distance of approximately 0.8 miles, to a spur, slopes northeasterly, at approximate latitude 35°37'58" North, 114°50'09" West;
14. thence northwesterly, a distance of approximately 0.9 miles, to a spur, slopes westerly, at approximate latitude 35°38'37" North, longitude 114°50'39" West;
15. thence westerly, a distance of approximately 0.4 miles, to a spur, slopes southwesterly, at approximate latitude 35°38'38" North, longitude 114°51'08" West;
16. thence northerly, a distance of approximately 0.4 miles, to a spur, slopes northwesterly, at approximate latitude 35°38'57" N., 114°51'02" West;
17. thence easterly, a distance of approximately 0.2 miles, to a spur, slopes northwesterly, at approximate latitude 35°39'00" North, longitude 114°50'49" West;
18. thence southeasterly, a distance of approximately 0.3 miles, to a spur, slopes northerly, at approximate latitude 35°38'55" North, longitude 114°50'29" West;
19. thence easterly, a distance of approximately 0.3 miles, to a spur, slopes southerly, at approximate latitude 35°38'53" North, longitude 114°50'08" West;
20. thence northerly, a distance of approximately 0.5 miles, to intersection with a line parallel with and 1,000 feet southerly of the centerline of the Four Corners-Eldorado electric transmission line, Bureau of Land Management serial No. N-868, at approximate latitude 35°39'18" North, longitude 114°50'03" West;
21. thence S. 87°28'30" E., a distance of approximately 1.1 miles, on a line parallel with and 1,000 feet southerly of the centerline of the Four Corners-Eldorado electric transmission line, Bureau of Land Management serial No. N-868, to a stainless steel post, 28 inches long, 2 1/2 inches diameter, set 5 inches in the ground over a plastic-encased magnet, and in a mound of stone, 4 feet base, to top, with brass cap marked IPWA N76658 2010 and a line indicating the direction of the boundary, at intersection with a line parallel with and 100 feet northwesterly of northwesterly edge of an unimproved road, at observed latitude 35°39'15.045" North, longitude 114°48'55.262" West;
22. thence southwesterly, turning southeasterly and northerly, a distance of approximately 0.7 miles, on a line parallel with and

100 feet northwesterly, southwesterly, and easterly of the northwesterly, southwesterly, and easterly edge of the unimproved road to a stainless steel post, 28 inches long, 2 1/2 inches diameter, set 22 inches in the ground over a plastic-encased magnet, and in a mound of stone, 3 feet base, to top, with brass cap marked IPWA N76658 2010 and a line indicating the direction of the boundary, at intersection with a line parallel with and 1,000 feet southerly of the centerline of the Four Corners-Eldorado electric transmission line, Bureau of Land Management serial No. N-868, at observed latitude 35°39'14.280" North, longitude 114°48'34.033" West;

23. thence S. 87°28'10" E., a distance of approximately 1.8 miles, on a line parallel with and 1,000 feet southerly of the centerline of the Four Corners-Eldorado electric transmission line, Bureau of Land Management serial No. N-868, to intersection with the line between Tps. 26 S., Rs. 64 and 65 E., identical with the northwestern corner of the National Park Service Ireteba Peaks Wilderness, at approximate latitude 35°39'10" North, longitude 114°46'37" West;
24. thence southerly, a distance of approximately 1.3 miles, on the line between Tps. 26 S., Rs. 64 and 65 E., identical with the western boundary of the National Park Service Ireteba Wilderness, also identical with the western boundary of Lake Mead National Recreation Area, to the corner of Tps. 26 and 27 South, Rs. 64 and 65 E., and the Point of Beginning.

The area contained within the bounds of this description is 10,330 acres, more or less.

#### END OF DESCRIPTION

The acreage noted is based on a GIS polygon projected onto the 1983 North American Datum Universal Transverse Mercator projection, zone 11.

The direction of each line is with reference to the true meridian.


The geographic positions noted as "approximate" latitude and longitude are referenced to the 1983 National Geodetic Reference System and are digitized values from the following United States Geologic Survey 7.5 minute quadrangle maps:

1. Ireteba Peaks, Nev., Provisional Edition, 1984
2. Nelson, Nev., Provisional Edition, 1984

The geographic positions noted as "observed" latitude and longitude are values determined from Global Positioning System(GPS) static observations processed by National Geodetic Survey Online Positioning User Service(OPUS) utilizing Continuously Operating Reference Stations(CORS): "NVTP TROPICANA CORS ARP", "NVLM AMS WT FACILITY CORS ARP", and "NVLM CARLTON SQUARE 2 CORS ARP", in 2010, and carried forward by Real Time Kinematic(RTK) observations.
