Description: The Meadowood Special Recreation Management Area offers numerous recreational opportunities outside of the Washington D.C. area. This project will repair the Colchester parking lot fences, creating boundaries to reduce vegetation and resource damage. The Wood Thrush Loop culvert will also be replaced, improving trail drainage and enhancing ecosystem restoration. These repairs will protect area resources and reduce safety concerns for the visiting public.
