Tread Lightly Agreement



Repaired Rolling Grade Dips

Amount Expended: \$10,000

The Field Office added funds to a State Office agreement with Tread Lightly to do trail repairs on a heavily used OHV trail. The added funds resulted in approximately 60 drainage structures being repaired over a six mile stretch on the Wickersham Creek Trail in the White Mountains National Recreation Area.

Amount Expended: \$7,800

The non-motorized Summit Trail in the White Mountains National Recreation Area is one of the most popular hiking trails in the Interior of Alaska. This year, recreation staff and an SCA team rerouted and added boardwalk to an area of the trail that is very muddy. Funds were used to purchase the material for the repair.
