Painted Rock Petroglyph Site and Campground

Amount Expended: \$52,432.13

Painted Rock Petroglyph Site and Campground is located west of Gila Bend. It has 59 individual campsites and two large group sites, along with 2 vault toilets and 2 shaded picnic areas. Numerous comments from the public have been received about how Painted Rock has the cleanest restrooms of any campground. This is thanks to the cleaning contractor selected which takes care of the restrooms both in and out of season.

Box Canyon Shooting Sports Site

Amount Expended: \$22,406.77

In late FY23, approximately \$15,000 was used for Law Enforcement and Park Ranger labor. These two programs are vital to the recreation program by providing public contact, enforcing regulations, and ensuring public safety.

With the opening of Box Canyon shooting sport facility in FY23 and approximately 2,774 visitors, extra staff time was needed to make for a positive visitor experience. Numbers are expected to increase significantly since the area is available for the full 2024 fiscal year.
