Our staff of Park Rangers and Outdoor Recreation Planners (ORP) maintain facilities in remote locations, and are prepared to re-supply these facilities as needed. We also download data from vehicle counters located throughout the field office; these data are processed and evaluated to inform management priorities and decisions.

We maintain the facilities located within the Little Sahara Recreation Area (LSRA), which includes 4 campgrounds, 40 vault restrooms, 10 restrooms with water, visitor center, pay booth, vendors row, visitor center grounds, barbecue stands, fire rings, picnic tables, kiosks, range fences, dump station and equipment yard.
