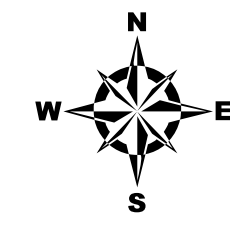

Road: Route designated for use by low-clearance vehicles having 4+ wheels and maintained for regular continuous use.

Primitive Road: Route designated for use by 4-wheel drive/high clearance vehicles (two-track).

Motorized Trail: Single-track route designated for use by motorcycles and E-bikes.

Non-Motorized Trail: Single-track route managed for use by human-powered and stock forms of transportation or historical or heritage values.

Technical Vehicle Site: Site primarily utilized for 4-wheel drive rock crawling.
